A Report on Shivswarjya day ceremony



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
A Report on Hygiene During Menstruation Program

Menstruation is a phenomenon unique to girls. However, it has always been surrounded by taboos and myths that exclude women from many aspects of socio-cultural life. In India, the topic has been a taboo until date. Such taboos about menstruation present in many societies impact on girls' and women's emotional state, mentality and lifestyle and most importantly, health. The challenge, of addressing the socio-cultural taboos and beliefs in menstruation, is further compounded by the low girls' knowledge levels and understandings of puberty, menstruation, and reproductive health. Thus, there is the need to follow a strategic approach in combating these issues.

On the occasion of International Women's day GES'S Students were taking initiative on 19 March 2022 to spread awareness in young girls in society as well as the women in rural places by giving sanitary pads to encourage them to use them instead of cloth. So the Students taught how to use and discard sanitary napkins as well as how to take care of hygiene during menstruation. Girls should be educated in maintaining the highest level of hygiene during periods. Also girl student of our college raise awareness in village women about poor menstrual hygiene practices which may cause reproductive and urinary tract infections in addition to rashes, itching, foul odour, and many other reproductive health morbidities. Poor menstrual hygiene management can also compromise women's educational and economic opportunities.




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



- Mr. Vishal B. Jadhav expressed his views on the said theme of National Science Day. He said that "Science for the People and the People for Science" is a slogan that emphasizes the importance of science being accessible to everyone, and that people should be empowered to use scientific knowledge to improve their lives and the world around them. The idea behind this slogan is that science should not be limited to academic or scientific communities, but rather should be integrated into everyday life and decision-making. This requires scientists to communicate their research in a clear and understandable way to the general public, and for the public to have access to scientific information and be able to participate in scientific discussions. On the other hand, the "People for Science" part of the slogan recognizes that scientific progress depends on the active involvement and support of the broader community. Citizens can contribute to science in various ways, such as participating in research studies, providing feedback and suggestions for scientific projects, and advocating for policies that prioritize scientific research and education. Overall, "Science for the People and the People for Science" represents the idea that science is a collaborative effort that benefits everyone, and that it is important to work towards a society where scientific knowledge is widely available, understood, and used for the betterment of humanity.

He said that The Raman Effect was the discovery which won physicist Sir CV Raman his Nobel Prize in 1930. Conducting a deceptively simple experiment, Raman discovered that when a stream of light passes through a diquid? activation of the light



scattered by the liquid is of a different colour. This discovery was immediately recognised as ground-breaking in the scientific community, being the subject of over 700 papers in the first seven years after its announcement.





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

A Report on Republic Day Celebration




Report on Kolhapur relief fund




A Report on International Yoga Day Celebration
