The institute's cutting-edge facilities improve the teaching and learning environment. The institute's policy is to provide infrastructure that complies with AICTE and PCI requirements to enhance it in response to development and expansion. Since its inception, the institute has upheld high standards for infrastructure to meet demands from industry and regulatory bodies with a built-up area of 3609.27 square metres in accordance with AICTE and PCI standards.

Classrooms: Class rooms and tutorial rooms are housed in a well-designed facility at the institute with a sufficient number of well-furnished, well ventilated, spacious classrooms equipped with LCD projectors for conducting theory classes. The College has ICT classrooms where the provision of Wi-Fi connectivity and internet access is given.

Laboratories: The Institute's laboratories are functional and well-equipped, and they have all the modern infrastructure tools needed for efficient operation with very advanced instruments like HPLC, UV Spectrophotometer, IR spectrophotometer, tablet compression machine, fluidised bed dryer, automatic tablet dissolution machine, etc. are taught to and promoted for use by students. The institute properly maintains SOPs for all of its advanced equipment and keeps log books to track usage.

ICT- enabled facilities: The Institute also offers an ICT enabled class rooms with a LCD projector and other audio-visual and multimedia tools. Every workspace within the institute, including faculty offices, computer labs, libraries, and administrative offices, has Wi-Fi connectivity for network connectivity and internet access. For protection and safety, a concrete wall surrounds the campus, and CCTV cameras are also set up throughout the institute and institute premises. Faculties and administrative employees each get a private cabin with access to a computer and the internet.

A Sports: College has a sizable playground where students can play outdoor games which preferably includes volleyball, basketball and cricket while indoor games preferably include carom, chess, badminton, and table tennis. The purpose of the institute's yearly cultural and sporting events is to encourage students to take part in university and intercollegiate competitions. For participation in various sporting events, pupils are given sports outfits. Sports events like cricket, volleyball, tug-of-war, and badminton are organized by the institute.

An Auditorium & Cultural Activity: The campus has an auditorium with a seating capacity of 700–800 people and a public address system.

A Gym and Yoga: The institute has gym and yoga facilities; herein students, faculty, and staff have access to a well-equipped gym on campus, along with a gym coach and in the gym, there are also spaces for yoga. Also, the institute commemorates World Yoga Day to raise awareness among the students.

Other Facilities: The institute has other facilities preferably includes a separate boys and girls hostel, a bank, a post office, a canteen, a drug museum, a display sections in each corridor, and a medicinal plant garden, an Institutional Animal Ethics Committee (IAEC) as per CPCSEA standards, a fire extinguisher, a ramps designed specifically for wheelchairs and a lift for a people with disabilities.
