DISABILITY FRIENDLY FACILITY POLICY

The College recognizes the importance of creating a climate of understanding and mutual respect to cater for the dignity and worth of each person, so that they contribute wholeheartedly to the development of Self, College, Society and Country at large.

The College propagates and strategizes to promote equal right and access to education for all those who are under privileged with physical disability. It is vigilant to the fact that despite a highly regulated and complex education frame work of the nation, it should be easily available for the students with "special needs".

The Persons with Disabilities Act 1995 indicates that differently abled persons may have access to education at all levels. In view, this college has created Disability Support Committee (DSC) to provide access to the differently abled students of the College to varied programs, services, activities and also encourage them for the highest levels of academic and personal achievement and advocate an accessible environment for them. The policy has been devised to promote the holistic development of differently abled students. Also, the college strives to create accessory and homely ambience and facilities for these students. It takes care to nurture them right from helping them to seek admission till they pass out from the college.

- Students with disability will have equitable access and practical support to participate fully in the College viz:
 - Access to academics, co and extra-curricular activities.
 - Access to buildings and facilities.
 - Receiving information in accessible formats.
 - Receiving high-quality service from faculty members and staff.

- To encourage them to participate in all the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
- To extend add on programs and opportunities for them.
