Day 1: Special Camp 24th December 2019: INAGUARATION

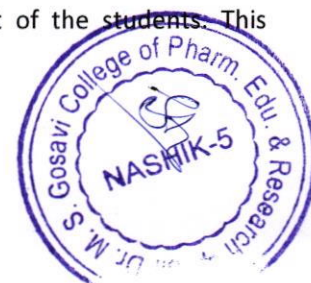

Date 07th Jan. 2019 to 13th Jan. 2019

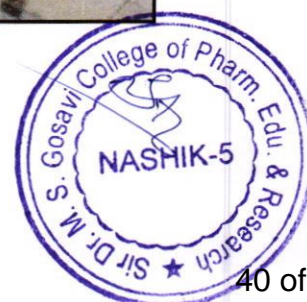

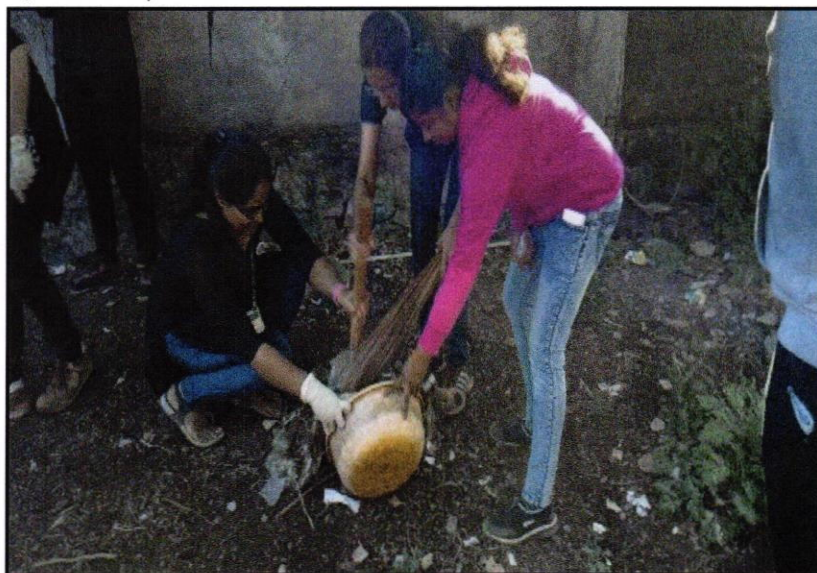

A report on Swachh Bharat Abhiyan

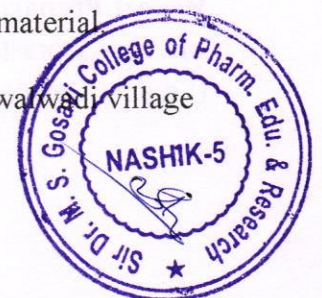

Swacchata Abhiyan

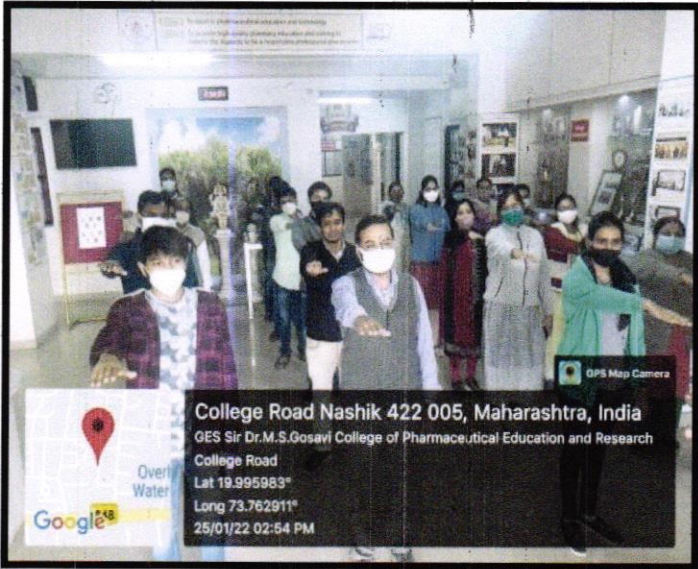

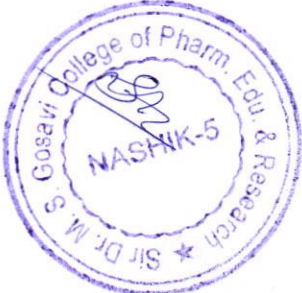


Tobacco Awareness

Voters Day Pledge

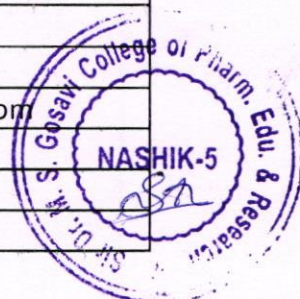

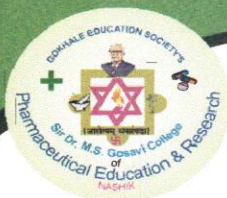

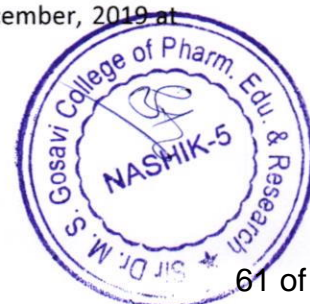
NSS REPORT (Special Camp)

Day 1: Special Camp 24th December 2019: INAGUARATION

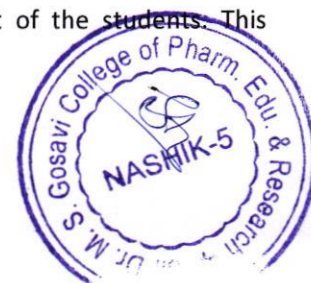
